The Duporth School was sold to the Ursuline Sisters to become an Ursuline convent between 1924 and 1957 before becoming the site of the now Canossa Hospital in 1965.

Mandy Julian, Village and Sales Manager is particularly excited by the connection Kingsford Terrace has to the broader community and its ties to the local history.

"I love the connection Kingsford Terrace has to the local community. Too often, retirement communities become exclusive enclaves with resident activity contained within the village.
